Vehicle Energy Japan receive Ford “Q1” award.

Tokyo, August 29, 2022 --- Vehicle Energy Japan Inc. (Representative Director, CEO, President and Chief Executive Officer: Hiroshi Ikeuchi/ Headquarter in Japan, hereinafter referred to as “VE-J”) received “Ford Q1” award from Ford Motor Company (Chief Executive Officer: James D. Farley, JR./ Headquarter in U.S.A).

“Ford Q1” is a quality control program that examines Ford suppliers for quality and control, and only those companies that meet the highest quality requirements are certified. Sawa Site has achieved the following four evaluation indicators set by Ford: Quality Performance (quality performance), Capable Systems (evaluation and production capacity of quality control standards such as IATF16949, ISO14001), Warranty Performance (service and guarantee in the market), Delivery Performance (delivery performance).
